

Ministry Objectives:

- 3- Equip and develop the staff of Orphanages and Care Centers besides the biological and adoptive families through conducting specialized training courses addressing Child developmental crisis, pains, traumas, and problems.
- 4- Working on eliminating the move of the child from his/her family to orphanage or care center through helping their families, by fulfilling their needs to enable them to keep their child. This help could be financial, medical, psychological, physical etc.
- 5- Working on providing foster homes/families for the children living in the Orphanages or Care Center so they entertain living in a healthy environment.
