## SANADAK Core Values

### **FAMILY**

Our vision is to see every child in a loving family. God designed the family and therefore it is the best solution to the global orphan crisis. Families are central to a child's optimal development and emotional security. Our goal is to meet children where they are, and helping them to become part of a permanent loving family.

### **RESPONSIVE LOVE**

To act upon God's call to care for orphans is not merely a matter of duty, guilt, or idealism. It is first a *response* to the good news, the Gospel: that God, our loving Father, sought us, adopted us, and invites us to live as His sons and daughters (Ephesians 1:5). Adaptation is God's call for His church.

### **COMPASSION**

We believe that one of the responsibilities of God's people and churches is to care for widows, orphans, and those who have been marginalized by the economic and social systems of the world. It is to that end that we come alongside the body of Christ to support orphanages and children's homes. James 1:27 makes very clear the mandate to care for orphaned children to His glory.

To meet only spiritual or only physical needs of a child is incomplete. Our goal is aiming at reinforcing their spiritual needs and their identity in Christ in parallel with their academic and carnal needs. (James 2:16)

### **RESIDENTIAL CARE**

Care within a family is our unequivocal ideal for children. Yet, we also honor the devoted care and protection provided by many institutional centers, supporting the kids learning difficulties in the orphanage is one of the most important priorities of our ministry. It is our commitment to inspire the children of the Orphanages in the Middle East to become active and prosperous citizens in his/her society.

### **SUPPORT**

The effects of trauma on children are significant and lifelong. Our goal is to support children in their healing process by providing a team specialized in counseling, and to ensure that their parents can successfully raise them to adulthood. Adoptive and foster families must have access to such supportive services to help them meet their child's needs so the entire family can thrive.

### **TRUSTWORTHINESS**

Being trustworthy is one of our key values, to ensure that we manage funds entrusted to us and channel them solely for the well-being of the children. Furthermore, we highly value transparency and openness. We hope to create systems that steward God's gifts well. We stand by our promises. We keep our word. And we hold our Covenant Partners accountable in doing the same.
